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


FALL 2021 ENROLLMENT FACTS

- A total of 1,890 students enrolled during the fall of 2021. This is a decrease of 2% from the fall of 2020, and 3% from the fall of 2017.
- Of these students, 63% are seeking an associate degree, 5% are seeking a diploma, less than 1% are seeking a certificate, 16% are enrolled in Early College High School, 14% are Career and College Promise, and 2% are seeking special Credit.
- Career and College Promise enrollment is down 15% from the fall of 2020, but is up 78% from the fall of 2017.
- A total of 1,232 students (65.2%) are female, compared with 1,246 (64.5%) in 2019 and 1,226 (60.8%) in 2018.
- In the fall of 2021, minority enrollment comprised 36.5% of the total enrollment, compared to 35.8% in the fall of 2020, and 34.3% in the fall of 2019.
- The current average age is 22.52, compared to 21.94 in the fall of 2020, and 21.98 in the fall of 2019.
- Most of our students are from Rockingham County with 80.4% (1,519) listing it as their county of residence. Guilford county makes up 10.7% (203), Caswell County makes up 3% (56), and out of state residents make up just 1% (18) of the fall enrollment.
- The largest percentage of our students are from Reidsville with 35.3% (668) listing it as their city of residence. Eden makes up 21.4% (405), Madison makes up 8.1% (154), and Stoneville makes up 8% (151).
- First time Freshman enrollment is up by 22% over the fall of 2020, but down 1% over the fall of 2019.






